

Teller Waterfowl Blind Locations

All of The Teller waterfowl blinds are located in areas that require some walk-in travel from the designated parking lots. The following directions will help guide hunters from the parking areas to the individual blinds. (Please refer to the 2009 Teller Bird Hunting Map for parking area locations.) There will also be directional signs located in the field to assist with blind location.

Spring Creek Blind

Starting at the parking lot, walk north on the east side of Spring Creek approximately ¼ mile to where the creek makes a sharp bend to the west. The blind is a wooden, above-ground blind located on the east side of Spring Creek.

North Blind

Starting at the parking lot, travel west along the road towards Gird Creek. Continue along the road heading north paralleling the creek for approximately ¼ mile until the road makes a turn to the right or east. At that point, walk due west across the creek. The wooden blind is located on the west side of Gird Creek.

Teal Blind

From the parking area, walk east down the road approximately 300 yards to the 2nd wooden, water-control structure which is on the south side of the road. Approximately 25 yards east of the water control structure, walk south across the ditch and turn slightly west towards the cattail marsh. Continue south paralleling the stand of cattails for approximately 160 yards to reach the blind. The blind is located near an opening in the cattails to the open water lagoon.

Wigeon Blind

From the parking area, walk east approximately 100 yards on the road paralleling the ditch to your south. Prior to the first wooden water-control structure, turn south across the ditch onto the road heading south. Continue south on this road approximately ¼ mile until the road make a 90 degree turn to the left or east. At that point, head south east across the dike. At the end of the dike follow signs south approximately 100 yards to the blind.

Mallard Blind

From the parking area, walk east approximately 100 yards on the road paralleling the ditch to your south. Prior to the first wooden water-control structure, turn south across the ditch onto the road heading south. Continue south on this road approximately ¼ mile until the road make a 90 degree turn to the left or east. At that point, head south east across the dike and continue to follow the signs across the field towards a second dike. Travel across the 2nd dike and turn north paralleling the cattails. The blind is located at the edge of the lagoon on the east side. **NOTE: Place your decoys close to the shore as wading retrieval may be difficult due to water depth and silt.**
